WASTE AUDIT

On Wednesday as a start to our "Waste Warriors" inquiry, Scott Martin from Enviroschools came and spent some time with us. First we completed a Waste Audit, where we looked at the rubbish and recycling we had created in one week. We talked about what should be recycled and looked at how we were doing.

We had quite a bit of recycling in the rubbish - we will work on sorting this better.

We analysed our rubbish and from the information we are now looking at what changes we could make around school to reduce what we are sending to landfill.









Scott then ran a compost workshop with the year 4-8s, we learnt about what makes a healthy compost heap and how we can get our looking a bit healthier.

Following our in depth look at our compost the Senior Class supported by Scott, looked at various compost systems and have decided to make a new three bay compost system.

The students have researched their idea, have developed a plan and now have a materials list for what they need.

It will be great to see this grow over the next few weeks.

WHO'S WHO?




