Well done New Zealand! After 101 days of COVID-19 in NZ it was announced that we have no active cases remaining - that is something to be truly proud of. As a school it means we are able to return to an even more normal 'new normal'. We have taken away the social distancing in class - we can fit 4 to a couch again, soft furnishings like beanbags will be allowed back into the classrooms and we will be able to share things like felts, pencils and staplers again. We will still be practicing enhanced hygiene - washing hands, sanitising and encouraging/ reminding safe sneezing/coughing.

Some children are returning to sports, which is really exciting for everyone, and we are beginning to get information about some inter-school sports events being replanned for the future. The first of these will be the Netball Tournament and Small Schools Cross Country. We look forward to being able to take part in them.

With the change in weather we have made sure the flood/snow ringing tree is all up to date. If we do have to make a decision to either change our start time or shut school due to weather/ice you will be contacted by a Board of Trustees member. In the first instance they will text you - please reply so they know that you have received the information. This will be followed up with a phone call if they do not get a reply text from you. The information will also be posted on Facebook. Any decision will be made by 7.30am.

Leeanah is coming in again on Friday to continue helping us with our Kapahaka mahi, this is another fabulous step back in our return to normal learning, the children get so much out of Kapahaka - we are really lucky to have Leeanah come and share her kaupapa me akoranga. Kia ora Leeanah.

Mrs Holden was in last week and the Leeks gardening group turned the potatoes we had grown into chips and made some bird feeders from pinecones and seeds. This week the Yams will be gardening. Thank you Mrs Holden for all you are sharing with our children. It is absolutely fantastic to have these relationships with our community members.


