It is great to see the sun shining again - even if it is just for a few days. School always feels so positive and looks so good when the sun is out!

We have had a busy few weeks at Waiwera South School. We had a high tea to commemorate the coronation of King Charles last week, all children made crowns and placemats and had a delicious high tea of the Kings Quiche, cucumber sandwiches and pikelets with cream. We thought that we had to mark such a significant historical event with something special.

The students have been lucky enough to enjoy a day in Dunedin looking at Larnach Castle and Olveston as an igniter for this terms inquiry, looking at how much technology has changed in our homes over time. Comparing Larnach Castle to Olveston, which were built approximately one hundred years apart, and then to our own homes is proving to be a very interesting exercise and quite an eye opener as to what it meant to live in the eighteen and nineteen hundreds. On Monday we had Jo Bennett from the South Otago Museum come to visit and share some interesting artifacts from the Clutha collection, alongside some stories and memories from her family history. It will be really interesting to see where the children take their learning.

We have had quite a lot of misplaced or wrongly homed uniform at present. Please can you check that the uniforms you have at home belong to you and if they don't, please return these to school as soon as possible. There are several hoodies missing which is odd as most of these have names on the back. Please can you also ensure that all of your uniform items are named and identifiable.


